**Agreement** Between MEMPHIS TYPOGRAPHICAL UNION  
No. 11, and MEMPHIS TYPOTHETÆ.

Memphis, Tenn., October 11, 1898.

*Present:* Wm. H. Johnson, R. L. Shepherd, H. P. Hanson,  
representing Memphis Typographical Union.

*Present:* A. B. Pickett, A. J. McCallum, Peter Tracy, and  
W. H. Bates, *ex-officio*, representing Memphis Typothetæ.

On and after Monday, October 31, 1898, the scale in Book  
and Job Offices in the city of Memphis, Tenn., will be as  
follows:

Nine hours to constitute a day's work. Rate of pay, 30  
cents per hour for compositors, and 38 $\frac{1}{3}$  cents for foremen.  
On Saturdays 8 $\frac{3}{4}$  hours will constitute a day's work.

For all time over nine hours the rate of pay will be 40  
cents per hour for compositors and 50 cents per hour for  
foremen.

This scale to remain in force for two years from October  
31, 1898.

The above is agreed to by a joint Conference Committee,  
with plenary powers, from Memphis Typographical Union  
No. 11, and the Memphis Typothetæ.
