The Mid South Writers' Association was started around 1978 by Paul Flowers, author, journalist, and columnist for the *Memphis Press-Scimitar* newspaper in Memphis, Tennessee. The group grew from meetings in Flowers' home to bimonthly gatherings at St. John's Episcopal Church, located at Central and Greer. The group published "Writers on the River", a bi-annual journal featuring the nonfiction, fiction, and poetry of Memphis writers.
