### FEES

Residents of Tennessee, registered for 12 semester hours in the Evening Division, will pay \$60.00 per semester. Those registered for fewer hours will pay \$5.25 per semester hour.

Nonresidents will pay \$112.50 for 12 semester hours or \$9.50 per semester hour for fewer than 12 hours.

These fees apply to all persons taking classes in the Evening Division, including persons enrolled in other divisions of the college.

A late registration fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each day elapsed after the first day of classes before completing registration.

## GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

Applications for change of course are made in the office of the Director of the Evening Division. No course may be added after September 20. No courses may be dropped after October 18.

Withdrawal from the college may be effected by advising the Director in writing. Failure to notify the Director officially will result in a grade of "F" in each course for which a student is registered. A student who withdraws after the 5th week of the semester will have his courses recorded by the Registrar as "WP" (withdrawn passing), or "WF" (withdrawn failing).

Veterans enrolling under Public Law 16 or 346 must file registration material with the Office of Veterans Affairs. Korean veterans should file schedule of classes with the Veterans office after paying the registration fees.
